D1 produces nine NFL Draft choices

Titans pick Kropog in fourth round

Nine football players who prepared at D1 Sports Training in Cool Springs were selected in last weekend's NFL Draft.

Among them was Tulane offensive tackle Troy Kropog, drafted by the Titans in the fourth round. Tennessee has drafted a D1 athlete for the past three seasons.

Mississippi offensive tackle Michael Oher became the third first-round pick from D1 when Baltimore made him the 23rd overall selection.

D1 has trained 45 athletes who went on to be drafted.
